


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Grade Book Summary Page

The Summary page shows unit averages and several other grade calculations for each student. In the image below, blue indicates columns that are only applicable when due dates are used.



A: Unit Average

Unit Average is a student's average for completed unit activities relative to the total possible points for the unit. Unit Average is shown on the Grade Book Summary page.

B: Overdue Activities

When due dates are used this column shows a student's number of overdue activities and links to the Overdue Activities report for Teachers

C: Days since Access

This column shows the number of days since a student last accessed a given course.



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D: On Schedule Percent

When due dates are used, On Schedule Percent is the student's number of overdue activities relative to the number of activities currently due expressed as a percentage. On Schedule Percent is shown on the Grade Book Summary page.

E: Quality of Work

Quality of Work is a student's average relative to the total points possible for completed activities. Quality of Work is shown on the Grade Book Summary page.

F: Grade to Date

When due dates are used, Grade to Date is a student's average for completed activities due through the current date relative to all activities due through the current date. Grade to Date is shown on the Grade Book Summary page.

G: Overall Percent

Overall Percent is a student's average relative to total course points, expressed as a percentage. Overall Percent is shown on the Grade Book Summary page.

H: Midterm & Final Grades

The Midterm and Final grade columns are used to enter any letter value that is significant to a school or program. For example, the Final Grade column can be used to record a grade, a pass / fail, or an incomplete.

I: Last Due Date

When due dates are set for all course activities, this column shows the due date for the last course activity.

J: Extension

Teachers can use the Extension column to indicate any type of extension they may grant a student. our teachers use this column to grant extensions for the Midterm and Final grade deadlines.

K: Grade Letter

Once a teacher enters a final grade, the Grade Letter column displays an icon teachers and mentors use to print a letter summarizing the student's performance for the course.
