Challenge

The organization provides courses and instructors to schools in Saudi Arabia that want to offer digital learning and instruction in English for students in grades 6-12. These schools aim to equip students with the digital skills they'll need in the future, meet the needs of students for whom blended/online learning is the best option, and serve students who are not local.

Solution

Learning Oasis turned to Apex Learning to help them transition from traditional instruction to mastery-based, personalized learning. Results

- 100% of students in all grades completed all courses, with a final grade above 90%.
- During the 2018-2019 school year, students in grades 9-12 achieved gains across all subjects on NWEA MAP scores from fall to spring testing. Students in grade 6 achieved gains across all subjects on MAP scores in all subjects, and students in grade 7 achieved gains in Language and Reading from fall to spring testing.
- During the 2019-2020 school year, students in grades 6 and 8 achieved gains across all subjects on MAP scores from fall to spring testing.

Journey to Digital Learning

Since partnering with Apex Learning, Learning Oasis has grown steadily, expanding course offerings and the number of students enrolled:

- 2017-2018: Started with 9 courses, serving 221 students in grades 7-10
- 2018-2019: Expanded to 18 courses serving 476 students in grades 7-11. In 2018 adopted lab rotation and flipped classroom models.
- 2019-2020: Expanded to 25 courses serving 816 students in grades 6-12. Their digital curriculum now covers all core subjects (English, math, science, social studies) as well as electives and AP courses.
- 2020-2021: Established a virtual school.
